- 12. Pentecostal prayer services and sermons, catholic pagan rites, like burning candles, takes over the SDA church.

GOD's Final Appeal Of Mercy To His People

"I want to tell you. I hate sin (repeated three times). I am charged to tell our people, that some do not realize, that the devil has device after device, and he carries them out in ways that they do not expect. Satan's agencies will invent ways to make sinners out of saints. I tell you now, that when I am laid to rest, great changes will take place, I want the people to know that I warned them fully before my death." February 24, 1915

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A MORE SURE WORD OF PROPHECY



The SDA church began as religious movement around 1840s. She did not begin for political or economical purposes. God established and founded this endtime SDA church, upon a strong and sure foundation the Bible, and the Spirit of Prophecy. (Isaiah. 8:20 & 2Peter. 1:19). 25 fundamental Beliefs outlines this un movable foundation or the Pillars upon the SDA church was founded.

For this reason, this endtime church has a unique position and mission to fulfill. "God has chosen a people to proclaim the 3rd angels message to the world. They are to be Separate Peculiar people in this world of churches who are transgressing His commandments" RH, June 21, 1898. Vol 3, p 584

The pioneers of this church endeavored to guide this church to this direction. But prophecy foretells that a new movement will arise within the church structure to divert Gods people away from this God given mission, hence a new religious movement would be established to carry on this satanic work of diverting Gods people to another direction.

THE PREDICTION IS AS FOLLOWS

"The enemy of souls has sought to bring in the supposition that a great reformation was to take place among Seventh-day Adventists, and that this reformation would consist in giving up the doctrines which stand as the pillars of our faith, and engaging in a process of reorganization. Were this reformation to take place, what would result?—The principles of truth that God in His wisdom has given to the remnant church would be discarded. Our religion would be changed. The fundamental principles that have sustained the work for the last fifty years would be accounted as error. A new organization would be established. Books of a new order would be written. A system of intellectual philosophy would be introduced. The founders of this system would go into the cities and do a wonderful work. The Sabbath, of course, would be lightly regarded, as also the God who created it. Nothing would be allowed to stand in the way of the new movement. The leaders would teach that virtue is better than vice, but God being removed, they would place their dependence on human power, which, without God, is worthless. Their foundation would be built on the sand, and storm and tempest would sweep away the structure."

God warns His people as follows

"Many urge that by uniting with worldlings and conforming to their customs they might exert a stronger influence over the ungodly. But all who pursue this course thereby separate from the source of their strength, becoming the friends of the world they are the enemies of God." PP 607

"In their efforts to reach the people, the Lords messengers are not to follow the ways of the world" Ev 508

"I am instructed to say.... there is to be no compromise in order to meet the worlds standard. Gods commandment keeping people, are not to unite with the world to carry various lines of work according to worldly plans and worldly wisdom" MM 61

"Gods workmen must not follow after the worlds practices and customs in the list" B Echo 5.21.1894.

It is made manifest that when church members follow the maxims of the world that spiritual discernment is gone. RH. 8.23.1892

"What was the origin of the great apostasy? how did the church first departed from th simplcity of the gospel? By conforming to the practices of paganism, to facilitate the acceptance of Christianity by the heathen." GC 384

Below are the steps that have been taken by the new movement within the church to undermine Gods truth and to divert the people of God from their God given mission.

"16And he brought me into the inner court of the LORD's house, and, behold, at the door of the temple of the LORD, between the porch and the altar, were about five and twenty men, with their backs toward the temple of the LORD, and their faces toward the east; and they worshipped the sun toward the east.17Then he said unto me, Hast thou seen this, O son of man? Is it a light thing to the house of Judah that they commit the abominations which they commit here ...?" Ezekiel.8

"Men in responsible positions will not only ignore and despise the Sabbath themselves, but from the sacred desk will urge upon the people the observance of the first day of the week, pleading tradition and custom in behalf of this man-made institution." SW June 28, 1904

"There is need of a Sabbath reform among us, who profess to observe God's holy rest-day. . . The Lord has a controversy with his professed people in these last days. In this controversy men in responsible positions will take a course directly opposite to that pursued by Nehemiah. They will not only ignore and despise the Sabbath themselves, but they will try to keep it from others by burying it beneath the rubbish of custom and tradition. In churches and in large gatherings in the open air, ministers will urge upon the people the necessity of keeping the first day of the week." RH, March 18, 1884 1RH 405

Hence these annual sunday prayer felloships By SDA church worldwide, is a fulfilment of the above predictions.
